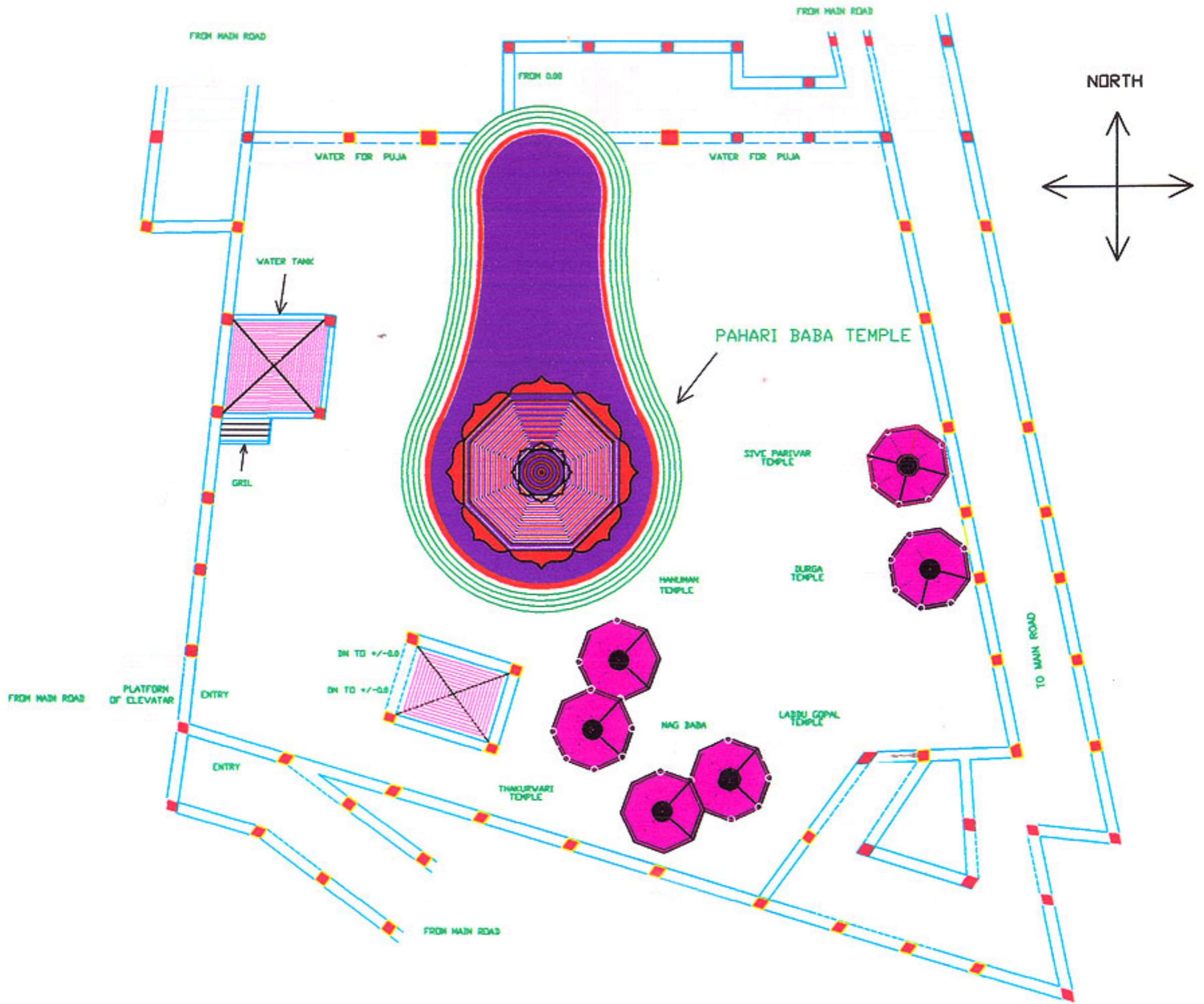


Kalasha, also spelled as Kalash and kalasa (Sanskrit: कलश, kalāśa; literally "pitcher, Kalasha pot")
